You can >>

Apply for a two year Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Health and Social Care (equivalent to one A Level).

You can gain a sound foundation of knowledge in health and social care practice.

You will have the opportunity to arrange different work placements. These will help you realise and extend your theory knowledge and help you gain experience and broaden your viewpoint in the operation of health and social care services. There will also be the opportunity to attend health related study days as they become available.

Plan to follow any career pathway in professional health and social care. It could also assist any student who wishes to improve their portfolio building and research skills ready for university.

Units 5 and 14 are internally assessed and externally moderated. Units 1 & 2 are examined externally.
